- The application will be reviewed and sent to the Flag Officers for approval.
- The Club Administrator will contact you, within 7 days, to confirm membership.



JUNIOR SAILING MEMBERSHIP

If parents are not members, the child must have completed at least two consecutive after-school sailing programs (summer sailing does not apply) and be signed up for the third to apply for junior membership.

The purpose of the RHADC Junior Sailing Membership is to encourage camaraderie among the sailors and promote sportsmanship and enjoyment of the sport of sailing.

Junior Sailing Memberships are offered to those sailors who are 8 – 16 years of age and active participants in the year-round RHADC sailing program. Membership is good for one year and may be renewed annually.

Those applying for Jr. Sailing Membership must complete the application form and sign the Code of Conduct. The \$100 membership fee will be charged to the Jr. Membership account, if approved.

Junior members will be issued a membership card & number: e.g. J880. In order to use your Junior Sailing Membership for charging purposes at the Club, a credit card must be kept on file in our Accounts Department.

Benefits of membership include:

- No monthly dues
- Ability to charge Food & Beverage only **(alcoholic beverages not permitted)**
- Free boat storage
- Liability insurance coverage during racing *
- Easy payment option when registering for lessons and camps

**Proof of liability coverage is a customary requirement within the sailing instructions for most classes of boats and is now making its way into the Optimist Class here in Bermuda*



JUNIOR SAILING MEMBERSHIP CODE OF CONDUCT

In order to maintain a controlled and safe learning environment, all Junior Members are expected to act in a mature and responsible manner.

We expect that you will:

- Treat other students, instructors, Club staff with respect, regardless of race, religion, gender or abilities.
- Not hurt other students, instructors, Club staff or members verbally, physically or emotionally nor tolerate such behaviour from others.
- Listen, learn and try to follow instructions from your instructors especially when safety procedures are given.
- Respect the equipment and the property of RHADC and treat it as if it were your own.
- Agree to be a good sportsman/woman at all times.

Should you do something that is wilfully wrong, you may be subject to the following disciplinary steps:

Step 1: The instructor speaks to the student – verbal warning. Given possible work details.

Step 2: The student is referred to the Sailing Director. Given possible work details.

Step 3: The Sailing Director speaks to the parents. Given possible work details.

Step 4: The Sailing Director writes the contract between students, parents and instructors.

Step 5: Removal from the class. The time is at the discretion of the Sailing Director and the Sailing Committee.

I have read and understood the Code of Conduct and accept that if I break one of them I must accept the discipline that may be imposed by my Instructor, the Sailing Director or Flag Officer of RHADC.
