1.	RULES					
1.1	The regattas will be governed by "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).					
2.	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY					
2.1 2.2	The regatta is open to RS21 fleet. Registration will be by delivering a completed entry form available online at www.rhadc.bm, and the registration fee, to the Sailing Office, no later than the day prior to the regatta, however the RHADC reserves the right to refuse an entry.					
3.	FEES					
3.1	Entry fee is \$150					
4.	SCHEDULE					
4.1	The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 11:55 hours on each scheduled race day. No warning signal will be made after 15:45 hours.					
4.2	A maximum of five races with be scheduled					
4.3	Races Abandoned or Postponed will be started as soon as practicable.					
4.4	Races not sailed on the scheduled race day will not be rescheduled and will be scored as void.					
5.	TIME LIMITS

6.1	The racing area will be either the Great Sound, Granaway Deep or Hamilton Harbour.					
6.2	The race area will be posted on the official notice board no later than 1000 hours on the scheduled race day.					
7.	COURSES					
7.1	Courses are described in the CC Sailing instructions.					
8.	SCORING					
8.1	The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply with no scores excluded.					
9.	RISK STATEMENT					
9.1	RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.' By participating in					
	this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks					
					s in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by	
	other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is					
0.0	the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.					
9.2	The OA will not accept liability for any material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with the regatta.					
10.	PRIZES & SOCIAL

10.2	Prizes will be given for First, Second and Third places.
